
Hour 1: Overview of the Body and Viral Hepatitis

This session will introduce attendees to the anatomy and function of the liver. The presenter will explain the impacts of viral hepatitis on the healthy function of the liver and assess participants' knowledge on the transmission, signs, and symptoms of viral hepatitis. The presenter will use an interactive card game to gauge student knowledge and guide discussion about viral hepatitis.

Hour 2: Discussion of Viral Hepatitis through Harm Reduction Principles

This session will review the basic principles and practices of harm reduction. These principles will guide the discussion of strategies for combating the transmission of viral hepatitis. The presenter will use group discussions and lectures to guide the dialogue.

Hour 3: Treatment, Management and Prevention of Viral Hepatitis

In this session, participants will discuss the treatment and management of viral hepatitis, including new treatment protocols. The instructor will help participants evaluate the degree to which their own agency gauges a client's risk for viral hepatitis. This discussion will be followed by a demonstration of risk assessment for viral hepatitis and a discussion about education goals around viral hepatitis.
