



Case Study: Victor

Victor is a 25-year-old man with a seven-year history of opioid use and a 12-year history of marijuana use. He has been diagnosed with depression and ADD but is not currently taking medication. He lives in a recovery home. This is his 5th treatment and in the past he has resumed opioid use very soon after returning to his parents' home. He wants to get into recovery and do something with his life but doesn't know what. He is a friendly and outgoing young man. He participates well in groups and frequently initiates conversations with staff and other residents.

Victor often states that he doesn't know what to do with his life. He wants to find a career but doesn't know what he likes to do. He likes to work and he likes earning money. He thinks he would like to stay in sober housing for as long as he can.

Victor has decided that he will take a couple of classes at Bunker Hill Community College to get some of the courses he'll need no matter what he decides to study.
