About the Position: C4 is seeking an Evaluation Advisor to support projects and initiatives that monitor, evaluate, and assess impact on individuals, communities, and systems. These projects evaluate a range of initiatives across C4's programmatic Centers, including recovery and behavioral health, housing and homelessness, youth well-being, and health equity. Activities across Centers include training, technical assistance, systems transformation, facilitation, resource development, and other initiatives delivered by C4. Projects also include the identification, development, implementation, and evaluation of emerging or best practices, environmental scans of relevant models or policies, community-based participatory research activities, including youth-led initiatives, and other projects that may include mixed-methods (qualitative and quantitative) evaluation approaches. Evaluation needs across programs and Centers vary, with some projects dedicated to evaluation and others incorporating evaluative

activities. The Evaluation Advisor will support Center Directors and Project Directors to design and implement a range of evaluation activities; ensure best practices in conducting evaluative activities, including community-based and qualitative evaluation; plan and conduct data collection and analyses; and comply with human subjects protections requirements. As a part-time on-call team member, available work hours will vary week to week based on project needs and up to a maximum of 20 hours per week.

Responsibilities:

- Provide consultation and advisory support on evaluation activities across multiple
 projects and programmatic Centers, including evaluation design and implementation,
 oversight of team members carrying out evaluation-related tasks, data collection and
 analyses, reporting, recommendation development, and compliance with human
 subjects research requirements.
- Provide consultation and advisory support on the implementation of community-based participatory research and evaluation strategies, working in close alignment with community partners including people with lived experience.
- Support development, implementation, and oversight of cross-Center evaluation and data collection protocols and staff training.
- Demonstrate and apply racial equity competencies and skills in carrying out evaluation and research activities.
- Support the creation and review of project reports, presentation materials, and other documents with evaluation components.

Requirements:

- Master's degree and at least 4 years' experience relevant to the role or equivalent background with 7 years' experience.
- Experience with qualitative data collection and analysis, including interviews, focus
 groups, and listening sessions with community stakeholders, including with people with
 lived experience.
- Experience with quantitative data management and analysis preferred, including SPSS.
- Experience with community-based program evaluation methods.
- Familiarity with behavioral health, housing, and other community-based social service agencies and systems.
- Excellent organizational skills.
- Ability to conceptualize, analyze, and follow-through with multiple, competing priorities.
- Ability to work independently at a high level in a fast-moving environment.
- Ability to act as a supportive team member.
- Highly developed verbal and written communication skills.
- Excellent computer skills and familiarity with PowerPoint and/or other presentation software.
